The Delaware FFA Vision Leadership Conference for High School FFA Chapters (9<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> graders) will be held at the Delaware State Fairgrounds Exhibit Hall, on January 28, 2022, with registration starting at 8:30 a.m. and opening session at 9:00 am. The program will conclude on January 28, 2022, no later than 3:00 p.m.

This leadership training is open to all high school FFA members and chapter officers. Each chapter attending must have at least one advisor to chaperone their members. Registration for the Vision Leadership Conference is open on Judging Card. Any chapter that has an outstanding balance from any other FFA leadership events will **NOT** be allowed to attend the conference if they are not paid in full, prior to January 18, 2022. Please complete the registration on Judging Card no later than **December 17, 2021. Please enter a shirt size for each attendee.**

There is no cost associated with this event as it is sponsored by Corteva. Chapters may bring an unlimited number of students to the Vision Conference. Dress is casual and should be appropriate for the weather. They will be able to wear their conference t-shirts that day. Lunch will be provided.
